- Develop local "clinic-community" linkage system to connect health care organizations, providers and patients with health promotion workshop opportunities in the community

By the Numbers

- 39 people trained as masters or leaders in the Chronic Pain Self-Management Program
- 17 partner organizations engaged to promote access to health services, including 11 community ambassador groups

Success Stories

- 1. Disbursed mini grants focused on health equity, along with training, resources, and support to 11 "community ambassadors" as part of Community Ambassador Project
- 2. Local community hub signed an agreement with a development group to build senior housing, a medical clinic space and a central kitchen to provide USDA reimbursable meals
